

Highlight – Cluster cattleyas (article provided by John Green)

This time of year is when many cluster and spotted *Cattleyas* bloom. I look forward to this each year. The ones I grow are hybrids and I find them easy to cultivate in our conditions. Like all orchids they appreciate new potting mix, which I endeavour to do every second year.

I pot them in a bark and charcoal mix in a pot, which allows enough growth for two years without getting too untidy. I always wait until the new growth on the plant has developed new roots before I repot. If the plants need dividing, I cut the rhizome in winter, which gives you a head start at potting time. These type of orchids are generally tall growers with some reaching one metre. I water very regularly while they are growing to encourage good growth. I use slow-release fertiliser on all my plants and not much else.

Most of these plants have waxy flowers which give them long lasting qualities so you can have large heads of flowers for a couple of months. One drawback is the size of the plants, which can be a problem if you have limited space but there are smaller growing cultivars.

Try growing some of these (pictured below), as they fill in a void when there is not a lot of orchids flowering. Good growing, John Green.


