Orchids are a large, worldwide, exciting family of plants that deserve attention beyond the casual glamour long associated with them. The beauty of wild species and elegance of cultivated hybrids are widely acclaimed. But orchids are a unique, highly evolved plant group of great scientific importance as well. Further, they are relatively hardy and can be grown, studied, and enjoyed by any interested amateur. Australia have so many native orchids that they are often taken for granted. Species are extremely variable in size and shape; some are fragrant, and a few have an unpleasant odour. Most are small-flowered.

Joe Tramacchi has done a lot of hard work updating our Gympie society website with all of the various species that grow in our local region (taking numerous photographs while hiking, and documenting their names and such), and as most club members missed out on watching the presentation, I highly encourage you to take the time to view all the hard work that Joe has completed on the subject and to make yourself knowledgeable on what orchids grow in our native area.


