Editors Highlight – Fireants

Fireants are now located on the Sunshine Coast. Protect your family, friends and pets by treating your property for fire ants. Proactive and responsive fire ant treatment helps stop fire ants from building nests and infesting your property until eradication treatment reaches your area. If you're in our suppression area, you can self-treat fire ants on land you own or manage.

How do you identify fire ants?

Fire ant nests: Iook like mounds or patches of loose soil have no visible entry or exit holes.	Fire ants: Unlike the black garden ant, fire ants have a few distinguishing features. • 2-6mm in length • a mix of sizes in one nest • copper brown in colour, with a darker abdomen.
Where to look, residential:	Where to look, rural:
lawns	around dams
footpath edges	edges of cultivated land
around garden beds	cropland
near taps	along fence lines
utility pits.	in and around piles of organic matter.

How to check:

- Gently poke the nest with a long stick. Don't touch!
- Look for ants erupting from the nest.
- Check the colour and size of the ants.
- **IMPORTANT:** When checking suspicious ant nests gently poke the nest with a long stick and observe the ants that come out. Be careful not to get too close, as fire ants are aggressive. They swarm when disturbed and have a painful sting.
